### What Do We Believe?

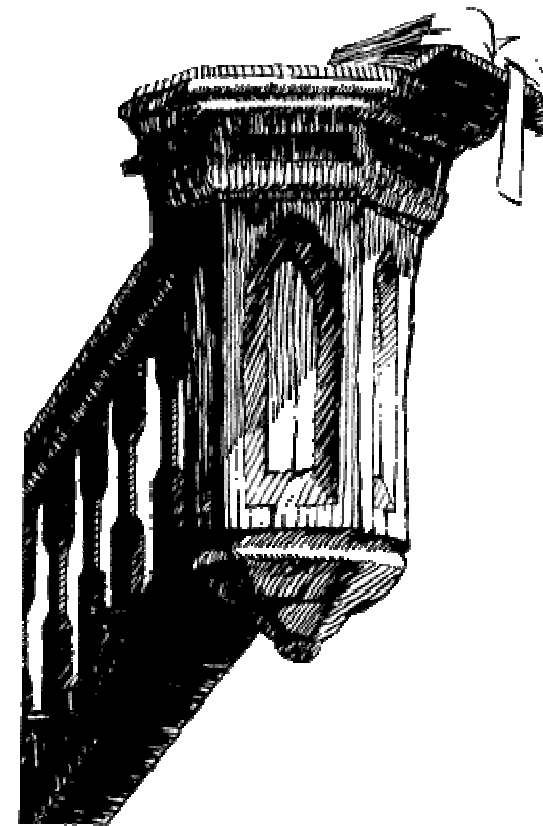
